“Campaigning and Representation”

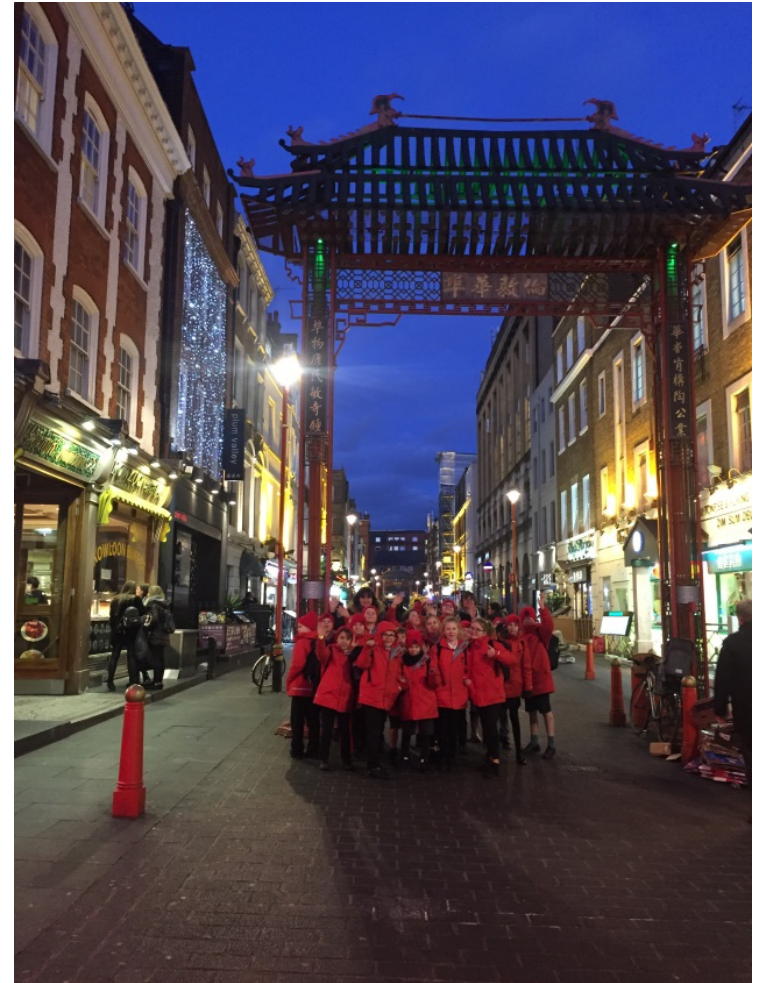
