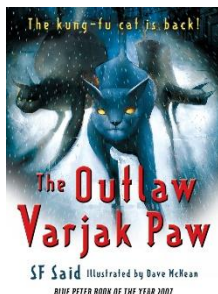

Curriculum



English In our writing lessons we will work on autobiographies, autobiography, poetry, dialogue in narrative, 1st person stories and poetry. In our reading lessons we will be reading the fantastic book "**The Outlaw Varjak Paw**" by **SF Said**.

Maths The children will be working on a range of mathematics this term, we will begin by working on Place Value (recognising numbers, counting, understanding the value of numbers, placing numbers in order), we will then move onto working on Addition and Subtraction, Multiplication and Division and Fractions. In their Friday maths lessons with Mrs Adams the children will be working on Geometry.

Science we will be studying Living, growing and changing.

History and Geography: Our **History** topic will be The Ancient Greeks and how they have influenced our lives. Our **Geography** will be about locating countries around the world and environmental biomes. In **Art** we will be learning about fonts and typography.

General information
